LOCAL OR NATIONAL	BENEFIT	EXPLANATION – HOW TO PARTICIPATE IF YOU CHOSE TOO:
LOCAL AERIE:	Daily Drawing Sign-up	While visiting the Aerie home each day, pay \$.50 for the Monday thru Saturday drawings and \$1.00 for Sunday. Pot amounts are listed on the board. The book is located at the left hand side of the bar. You must be physically present in the building to signup! You need to have your paid up dues card to claim prize! #2883 Members only!
	Monthly Sign-up	While visiting the Aerie pay the required \$5.00 signup amount and sign the book. If signed up and present you win the whole pot as is it stands at the time, if not present but signed up the person is awarded 50% of the pot. If the first person out is not signed up, then the drawing continues and the first person signed up and present wins \$100. The pot is capped at \$5000 and if there are 2 \$5000 pots, an attendance required drawing would be held – you must be signed up and present to win the pot and there is no pay out to anyone who is not present. Pot amounts are listed on the board. The book is behind the bar, just ask bartender for Monthly Sign-up. You need to have your paid up dues card to claim prize! #2883 Members only!
	Queen of Hearts Drawing	This drawing occurs on Thursday evenings at 7:30 PM. To be eligible you must purchase Queen of Hearts tickets (\$5 for 5 tickets minimum), sign them with your name as it appears on your dues card, turn the tickets in to the bartender or drop into the drum. If you are drawn out of the drum you get a chance to pick a card. There will be 2 drawn from the drum per week. The Jokers get 10% of the pot, the Queen of Hearts you get 75% of pot if present at the drawing or 50% of the pot if not present and you are drawn and the Queen gets picked. Need to have your paid up dues card to claim prize! #2883 Members only! Pots are capped at \$30,000!
	Tip Jars and Other Special Gambling Games	Tip jars are sold at the bar along with other gaming. Choice boards are run during events such as Monthly Drawings and Queen of Hearts. Wheel of Chance is run at the Monthly Drawing and Queen of Hearts and other special events. Wednesday is Jackpot day! Maximum single purchase is \$20 at a time All winners must be claimed within 30 Days All payouts should be tendered before leaving the club to assure proper accounting of the Tip Jars and payouts should be tendered from the jar it was bought from.
	Seasonal Dinners	Christmas Dinner, Fathers Day Dinner, Mothers Day. These cost \$5.00 each to attend, this cost is used to determine attendance to reduce food waste, the money is donated to a local charity.
	Pool Leagues, Skillpool Leagues, Setback League	These are Fall through Spring Leagues and you should inquire with Aerie teams prior the season to participate.
	Aerie Picnic	This picnic is usually held the first Saturday after Labor Day. There is a \$5.00 dollar charge for members and \$10.00 for 1 guest per member.
