

HOUSE RULES

Revised March 26, 2018

RULE 1 - The Trustees shall have control of the Aerie Home under the direction of the Aerie and shall employ, discharge, and have control of all employees of the Buffet and Social Rooms.

RULE 2 - The Social Room and Buffet shall be in the charge of the Trustees and shall be open and closed as such hours as are compatible with the existing State and Municipal laws and conditions in the community.

To-Wit:

Aerie #2883 will be open to Eagle members and Auxiliary member from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. Monday through Thursday. Friday and Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. Sunday hours will be from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. with the trustees empowered to set the hours conclusive. Eagles and Auxiliary members will be permitted with male or female guest, but no public.

RULE 3 - Aerie #2883 will be open to members and guests, for dances, or special occasions under the control of the Trustees and leagues, receptions, etc. An Eagle member or Auxiliary member may bring the same guest to the club three (3) times in a 12-month period. Guest will be required to sign the guest book, except for husbands, wives, or significant others of the member or auxiliary member. The third time the said guest, excluding spouses or significant others, visits the Aerie accompanied by an Eagle member or Auxiliary member, he/she will be required to sign a membership application. Guest living outside a 50-mile radius of the Aerie is not subject to this rule. Eagle Members or Auxiliary Members bringing guests into the Aerie Home must accept all responsibility for the conduct of such guests during their visits. Guests must leave the Aerie Home when the sponsoring member leaves. A key card will be furnished to members for the doors. While in the Aerie the guest will be treated as a possible member of the Aerie or Auxiliary. Any person who has been rejected in an attempt to become a member will not be allowed to enter the club or attend any club functions or private functions in the club.

RULE 4 - The Club Room will remain open during meetings, special meetings and on all occasions as permitted by law with the provision that the Outside Guard or bartender must at all times try to keep all noise or anything that will disturb the meeting to a minimum. Card Room will close at 12:00 a.m. with no exceptions.

RULE 5 - Intoxication, indulgence in profane, vile and boisterous language on the part of the members or guests within the home is strictly prohibited. The possession or use of any illegal or controlled substance on Aerie property is strictly prohibited. Violation of this rule by any member shall be subject to the action of the Trustees under House Rule #6 and may require charges to be preferred against him at the next meeting for the conduct unbecoming an Eagle.

RULE 6 - The Board of Trustees shall enforce the House Rules and be responsible for the preservation of orderly and gentlemanly conduct of all members and guests in the Buffet and Social Rooms, and the said Board shall have the power to deny privileges for a period of 30, 60, or 90 days to any member who shall have violated any house rule prohibiting intoxication, disorderly conduct or profane, indecent or improper conduct.

RULE 7 - Card Room is open to #2883 members only. Cards may be played in the front and center rooms. No card playing in the bar area, with no exceptions.

RULE 8 - When any member destroys or damages any property of the Home or Aerie, and refuses or fails to pay full value thereof, he/she will have legal charges filed against them by the Board of Trustees.

RULE 9 - It shall be the duty of the Trustees, through orders to the custodian, to keep all club and lodge property in a clean, attractive and sanitary condition. Every member is enjoined to help the custodian to keep the Home in a neat and attractive condition.

RULE 10 - No refreshments shall be sold except upon payment in cash and then only shall the same be served in the Card Room or Buffet.

RULE 11 - Section 63.2.c. Statutes, F.O.E. will be rigidly enforced. Offenses against the laws of the Order shall include, but shall not be limited to, any conduct unbecoming and Eagle, which shall include any violation of House Rules and personal conduct likely to bring disgrace upon the order.

RULE 12 - Children must be accompanied by parents or guardian and must be seated at a table away from the bar. No children will be allowed in the Aerie after 8:00 p.m., except when the kitchen is open for members and their families and on special occasions.

RULE 13 - Shoes and shirts are required to be worn in the Aerie.

RULE 14 - No double-parking on Potomac Street. No spinning of tires or littering on club property. No parking adjacent to the building unless you are in the Aerie Home.

RULE 15 - For daily and Sunday sign-up, member must be present in the bar area.

RULE 16 - When sign-up gets to two (2) full pots, a name will be drawn until we have a winner the next day. The Sunday drawing will be drawn the following day.

RULE 17 - No outside food or drink shall be brought into the club, except for special occasions. All beverages and alcoholic drinks must be purchased through the club. Refer to On-Premise Event Contract for details.

RULE 18 - There is a **\$50.00** per check fee on all returned checks.

RULE 19 - CAMPAIGN RULES FOR ELECTION OF OFFICERS:

- a No campaigning within 25 feet radius of Aerie Building during election.
- b Campaign literature will not exceed 9" X 12" (flyer type) and will be posted in designated area only. Campaign literature is only to be distributed and/or displayed on Aerie property.
- c Campaigning outside of Aerie will be limited to the distribution of Flyers Only! No food, drinks or other such vote enticements shall be permitted.
- d Location for campaign literature inside Aerie will be located in Main Hall on tables designated for campaign literature. All campaign literature will be removed at the start of the election and returned to candidates.
